Sacramento County Civil Service Commission November 2, 2018 Meeting

ADOPTED ACTION MINUTES

- <u>Call to Order</u>: The meeting was called to order by Commission Chair Patricia Macht at 1:30pm on Friday, November 2, 2018 in the Chambers of the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors, 700 H Street, Sacramento, California.
- 2) <u>Pledge of Allegiance</u>: Chair Macht led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3) <u>Roll Call and Declaration of a Quorum</u>: Roll was called by Acting Commission Clerk Gina Volpi, and it was noted that Chair Macht and Commissioners Michael Johnson, Bruce Nelson, Gordon Purdy, and Ron Suter were present. A quorum was declared.

can decide to hold the hearing in closed session or entertain a motion in open session addressing the appeal.

8) <u>Accept the Department of Personnel Services' Monthly Provisional Appointments</u> <u>Status Report</u>:

<u>ACTION</u>: Motion by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Johnson, to accept the DPS Monthly Provisional Appointments Status report for September 2018. The motion was adopted unanimously (5 to 0).

9) <u>Approve the following recommended changes to the Sacramento County Classification Plan</u> resulting from the Auditor series class study:

Revise the following classes within the Auditor series: Auditor I/II; Senior Auditor; and Audit Manager. Proposed revisions include changes to the minimum qualifications.

<u>ACTION:</u> Motion by Commissioner Nelson, seconded by Commissioner Suter, to adopt Executive Officer Dowdin Calvillo's recommendation: 1) Approving DPS' proposed revisions, including changes to the MQs, (dated September 4, 2018) to the Classification Plan revising the following three classifications within the Auditor series: Auditor I/II (retitle to Auditor); Senior Auditor; and Audit Manager classifications; and 2) Referring the newly Commission approved revisions to the Classification Plan to the County Board of Supervisors for its review and approval. The motion was adopted unanimously (5 to 0).

11) <u>Executive Officer's Report</u>:

Executive Officer Dowdin Calvillo informed Commissioners that the next Commission meeting was scheduled for November 16, 2018 but that the meeting will likely be cancelled. She told Commissioners that at the December 7, 2018 meeting they may hear one exam disqualification appeal.

She reported that she received one exam disqualification appeal that week and closed one exam disqualification appeal as it was administratively resolved. She said that there are five releases from probation, four exam disqualifications; two exam evaluations; and one failed drug appeal currently pending before the Commission.

Seeing no further business before the Commission, Chair Macht adjourned the meeting at 1:51 pm after it was moved by Commissioner Nelson and seconded by Commissioner Johnson with the motion adopted unanimously (5 to 0).
