F. Department of Personnel Services And Sacramento County Airport System AMENDED 1) Proposed Revisions To The Class Of Chief, Airport Fire Fighting And Airfield Operations, Inclusive of Minimum Qualifications And Re-titling To Fire Chief, Aircraft Rescue And Firefighting; 2) Proposed Revisions To The Class Of Fire Operations Supervisor, Inclusive Of Minimum Qualifications, And Re-titling To Fire Captain, Aircraft Rescue And Firefighting; 3) Proposed New Class Of Fire Battalion Chief, Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting; 4) Proposed Revisions To The Firefighter, Aircraft Rescue And Firefighting (Level I/II) Class Specification; And 5) Proposed Abolishment Of The Assistant Chief, Fire Rescue Operations Class

<u>ACTION</u>: By unanimous vote of those present, continued the matter to the July 27 meeting to allow Department of Personnel Services to confer with the Commission's Executive Officer in an effort to amend the language of the Fire Chief, Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting minimum qualifications so that 1) candidates could qualify who have completed coursework toward a major in the degrees listed; and 2) there is a path allowing career service employees to qualify who have substantial experience but no degree; and 3) all licensing and certification requirements be removed from the minimum qualifications section and moved to a subsection entitled Special Requirements.

<u>ACTION</u>: By unanimous vote of those present, adopted the new class of Veterinarian, as recommended in the Department of Personnel Services June 1, 2007 report.

H. Department Of Personnel Services And Municipal Services Agency: Proposed New Class Of Sanitation District Purchasing Manager, Inclusive Of A 12-Month Probationary Period

<u>ACTION</u>: By unanimous vote of those present, adopted the new class of Sanitation District Purchasing Manager, as recommended in the Department of Personnel Services June 1, 2007 report.
