- 2. <u>Directed</u> that the language as may be amended from time to time be added to the Continuing Education Requirement under the General Qualifications section, so that it reads: "Incumbents assigned to the Paralegal class are required to meet mandatory continuing education requirements pursuant to California Law, Business and Professions Code, Section 3645(d), as may be amended from time to time....."
