<u>ACTION:</u> By unanimous vote of those present approved as submitted by Department of Personnel Services in their September 8, 2009 report, as modified by the Commission at its October 16, 2009 public hearing, and as amended in the DPS October 22, 2009 *Revised* report as noted below:

- 1. Under the <u>Minimum Qualifications</u> section for each new class, add the word "full time" before each occurrence of the word "experience."
- 2. Under the <u>Minimum Qualifications</u> for the new <u>Sanitation District Real</u> <u>Time Process Control Systems Analyst (Level I/II)</u> class, change the educational requirement so that it reads:

Completion of 60 semester units or more (or 90 quarter units or more) at an accredited college or university with a minimum of 30 semester units (or 45 quarter units) in computer science, engineering, or other field closely related to the intent of the class; E. REPORT BACK: Department Of Personnel Services Report On The Status Of The Principal Building Inspector Examination Following The October 16, 2009 Civil Service Commission Official Interpretation Of The Principal Building Inspector Minimum Qualifications, That The "And" Section Requiring, "Three (3) Years Of Experience As A Building Inspector In A Building Code Inspection Program", And The "Education Substitution" Section Apply To Both The First And Second (*Either and Or*) Minimum Qualification Patterns.
