- 2) The restricted class "B" firefighter license requirement with a Tank Vehicle Endorsement; and
- 3) The language, "A Bachelor's Degree in a field directly related to the intent of this class is preferred".

ACTION: By unanimous vote of those present, **continued consideration** of the matter to the July 8, 2011 meeting, directing that the License Requirements section under General Qualifications be revised to require a valid drivers' license as discussed during the public hearing.
